

UGL selected as O&M and EPC contractor for Kidston Solar Project

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Genex Power has appointed Australian engineering and property services company UGL as both Engineering, Procurement, and Design (EPC) and Operation and Maintenance (O&M) contractor for its 50MW first phase of the photovoltaic (PV) solar project at Kidston in North Queensland.

Genex Power chose UGL out of seven shortlisted proposals after an extensive discussion and consultation process.

Managing director of Genex Power Michael Addison said: "The Board of Genex is pleased with the appointment of UGL as the company's preferred EPC and O&M contractor.
